

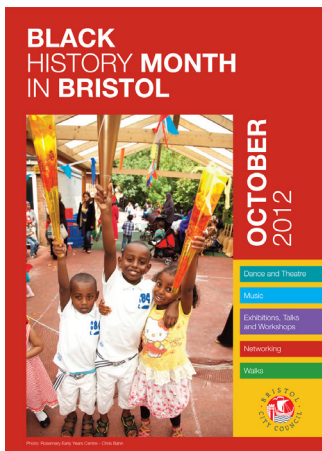

Our publication will highlight the Heritage of the Caribbean, African and the black diaspora communities. It will have an online presence with links to social media networks.

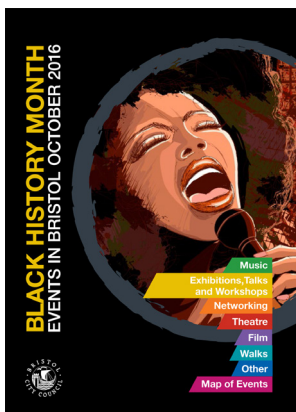
